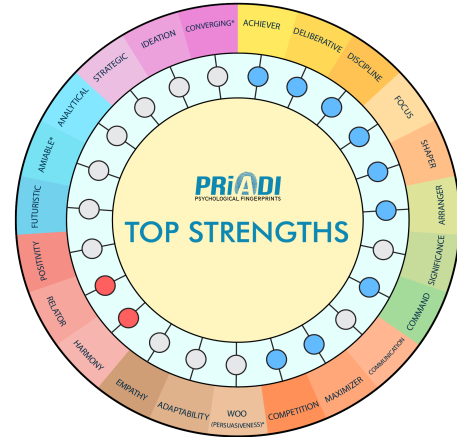


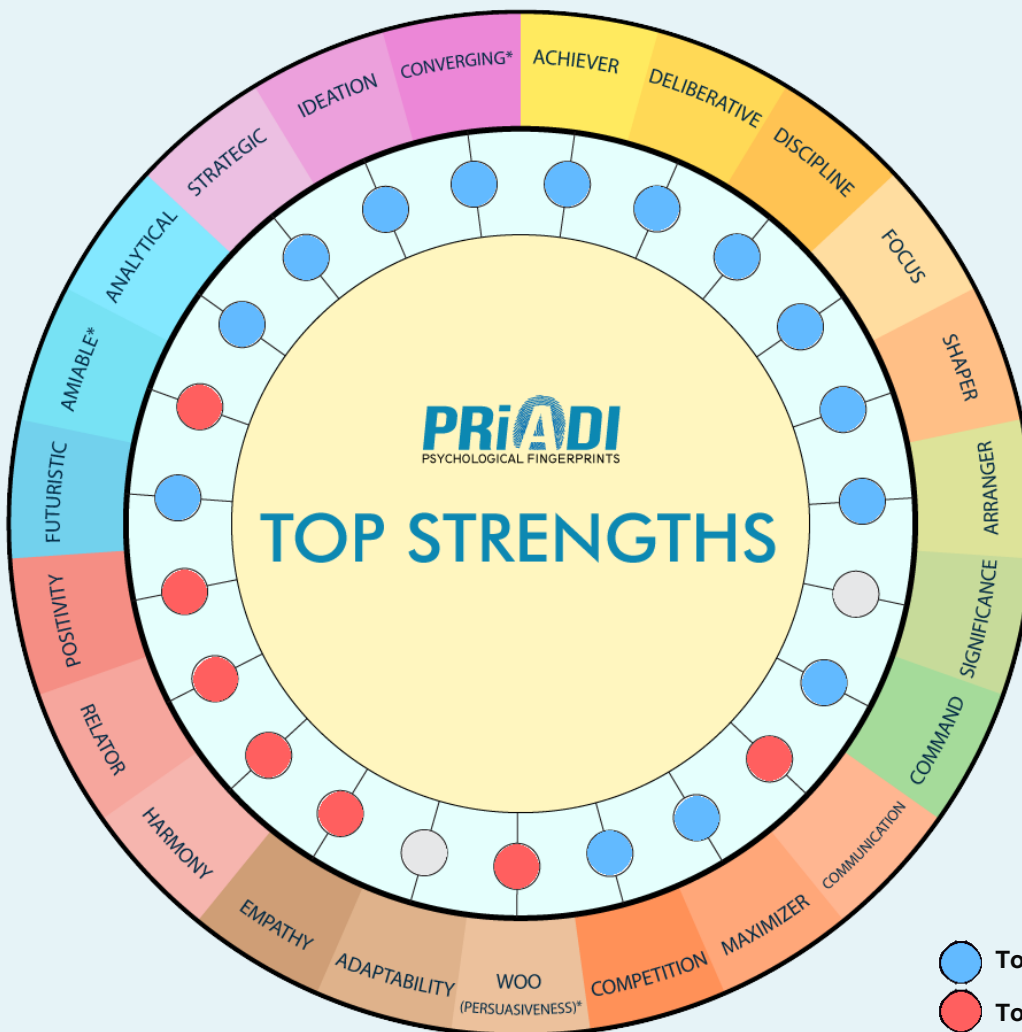


TOP STRENGTHS

Top Strengths of Personality is mostly refer to the theory of strengths and psychology by Don Clifton & Tom Rath (2007). Not all the strength themes can be accommodated by PRiADI Test, some are not included due to the suitability issues with PRiADI description, and some other strength themes (* sign) is included by PRiADI inventor because there is a harmony in themeâ€™s language and accuracy with PRiADI test device. In PRiADI Test, strength character of a testee (see picture on the side) is shown as 'blue dot' sign which indicates that testee has a certain specific strength: achiever, shaper, deliberative, arranger, maximizer, discipline, competition, focus, and command. Meanwhile, 'red dot' sign shows the lowest strength a testee has: relator and harmony. Meanwhile, 'gray dot' sign indicates that testee tends to have a moderate strength in that character. This result suggests that 'even though testee is considered well in leadership character and has a high work focus, testee has a relatively high tendency to have a conflict compared to the average population'.
